Diplomates certified prior to 2011 have prorated CME requirements to phase-in the implementation of a new recertification policy.

Applicants may be required to sit for the recertification examination in year 9 or 10 depending on examination availability. Please check the posted examination schedule to determine subspecialty specific examination availability.

UCNS recommends earning an average of 30 CMEs per year to assure that all CME requirements are met at the time of application for recertification.
