9	board, or possess equivalent certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of
10 11	Canada (RCPSC) or the American Osteopathic Association (AOA) [other as specified by the
12	Subspecialty]. a. Applicants applying under the internationally trained faculty pathway must have a
13	medical diploma from an institution registered in the World Directory of Medical
14	Schools.
15	b. Applicants applying under the internationally trained faculty pathway must be
16	certified in his or her primary specialty by a competent medical board. Such a board
17	may include, a) an appropriate board of the European Union of Medical Specialties
18	(EUMS), or b) the medical board of the applicant's country of origin, such board to be
19 20	approved by the Certification Council. 2. Applicants must hold a current, active, valid, unrestricted, and unqualified license to practice
21	medicine in at least one jurisdiction in the United States, its territories, or Canada, and in each

24	subspecialty certification must hold a valid license to practice medicine in the United
25	States, its territories and possessions, or Canada.
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27 28	A license to practice medicine is not "current, active, valid, unrestricted and unqualified" if, in any manner to any extent whatsoever, one or more of the following applies. The license is:

Such an offer must be written by the chairperson of the appropriate 145 department of the academic institution and state: a) when the appointment began or 146 will begin, b) that the appointment is contingent upon the applicant sitting for, and 147 passing, the next available UCNS certification examination, and c) that retention or 148 recruitment of the applicant is considered by the institution to be essential to the 149 quality of the fellowship program. 150 b. Applicant must provide documentation of a 36-month period of time in which the 151 applicant has spent a minimum of 25% of his/her time in the practice of [Subspecialty]. 152 Practice time requirement will mirror the requirement stated in the practice track for 153 each subspecialty. The practice must: 154 Have occurred in the 60 months immediately preceding the applicant deadline Ι. 155 but need not be continuous. 156 The application must contain a letter from the chairperson, using the Subspecialty 157 Practice Time Verification template, confirming the practice time requirement has 158 been met. The letter must address the entire practice time period being submitted. 159 c. Certification is linked directly to the diplomate's appointment on the faculty of a 160 UCNS-accredited fellowship. That is, if the diplomate no longer is on the faculty of a 161 UCNS-accredited fellowship, his or her certificate automatically terminates. In effect, 162 Faculty certification status is issued jointly to the faculty member and his or her 163 employing institution, which vouches for the faculty member's competence. 164 165 166 167 168 169
