1 **Neuro-oncology Program Requirement V.B. Fellow Eligibility**

- 3 **1. The fellow must possess a current valid and unrestricted license to practice medicine in the**  
4 **United States or its territories or Canada.**
- 5 **2. The fellow must be a graduate of a residency program in neurology, child neurology, neurological**  
6 **surgery, radiation oncology, internal medicine and medical oncology, or pediatrics and pediatric**  
7 **hematology-oncology accredited by ACGME, RCPSC, or CanERA.**
- 8 a. Fellows who have completed post-graduate training in an ACGME-, RCPSC, or CanERA-  
9 accredited medical oncology or pediatric hematology-oncology fellowship, or have completed  
10 a minimum of one year of an ACGME- or Can-ERA accredited medical oncology or pediatric  
11 hematology-oncology fellowship may also be eligible for enrollment; however, the Neuro-  
12 oncology fellowship will not be deemed complete until the successful completion of the medial  
13 oncology or pediatric hematology-oncology fellowship program. Appropriate documentation  
14 regarding the enrollment status of the fellow must be provided to UCNS.
- 15 **3. The fellow must be board certified or eligible for certification by the ABMS, RCPSC, AOA, or CFPC**  
16 **in neurology, child neurology, ~~neurosurgery~~-neurological surgery, medical or pediatric oncology,**  
17 **radiation oncology, ~~or neuropathology~~. The fellow is also eligible if board certified or eligible for**  
18 **certification in internal medicine or pediatrics and with proof of enrollment in an ACGME- or**  
19 **CanERA-accredited medical oncology or pediatric hematology-oncology fellowship program.**
